Session scope

The scope covered in New Product Technology (hereinafter referred to as the "NPT") Session is as follows. Technology presentation on:

- products sold or shortly planned to be sold on the market
- services provided or shortly planned to be provided on the market using the products
- manufacturing devices of the products
- development equipment (e.g. measuring equipment)
- software products for development or manufacturing

The products include: Vehicles with motor such as ATVs, Motorcycles, Scooters, Personal mobility vehicles, Marine products, Snowmobiles, Recreational vehicles, Utility vehicles, Power assist devices, Assisted bicycles and Unmanned vehicles. Machineries with motor such as Snowplows and blowers, Portable power generators, Agricultural machinery, Construction machinery, Forestry machinery, Gardening Equipment, Hand tools, Small and micro-combined heat and power systems.

Materials of metals, plastics, rubbers, fuels, lubricants, coolants and so on.

Mechanical components of bearings, bolts, springs and so on. Electrical components of controllers, motors, batteries, connectors, cables, lightings and so on.

Note: Automobiles, Large Vessels, Large Aircraft, Locomotives, and Spaceships are out of the subject.
